MERGING TRAFFIC

When two lanes merge into one, which may be indicated by signs such as 'FORM ONE LANE', 'LANE ENDS MERGE LEFT', 'LANE ENDS MERGE RIGHT' or signs showing two arrows merging, you must give way to another vehicle if any portion of it is ahead of you.

You should also use your indicator or hand signal to show that you are merging.

Remember to keep a safe distance between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you and take turns to merge if there are long lines of merging traffic.
